

**Winter water level standards are now in effect.** Winter water level management goals are to maintain stable levels below full pond, providing storage capacity for late winter/early spring snow-melt and runoff. The table below gives current lake levels and compares to the winter standards. **Annabessacook Lake and Narrows Ponds are above the winter water level standards, by one inch and 7 inches respectively.**
